



## *Peninsula Dog Fanciers' Club, Inc.*

### **Constitution**

#### **ARTICLE I**

##### **Name**

#### **SECTION 1:**

The name of the Corporation shall be The Peninsula Dog Fanciers' Club Incorporated herein referred to as the "club" incorporated in the State of Washington (Articles of Incorporation No. 1 145681 filed for the record in the office of the Secretary of State) January 30, 1950, at 4:05 PM, recorded in Roll 5, Page 1324-1334-A of Domestic Corporations.

#### **ARTICLE II**

##### **Objectives**

#### **SECTION 1:**

The club objectives shall be:

- a. To further the advancement and knowledge of all breeds of purebred dogs.
- b. To do all in its power to protect and advance the interest of all breeds of purebred dogs and to encourage sportsman-like competition at dog shows and obedience trials.
- c. To conduct sanctioned matches, dog shows, obedience trials, and any other events for which the club is eligible for under the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club.
- d. To provide education and support to the community and its agencies, and to the dog fancy in general, through donations, seminars, clinics, workshops, classes, and volunteer services.
- e. To offer social activities within the membership of the club.

#### **SECTION 2:**

The club shall not be conducted or operated for the profit of any member and no part of any profits, or remainder, or residue from dues or donations to the club shall inure to the benefit of any member or individual.

**SECTION 3:**

The members of the club shall adopt and may from time to time revise such by-laws as may be required to carry out these objectives.

**ARTICLE III  
Organization**

**SECTION 1:**

The club shall be governed by the members of the corporation who shall elect a board of directors, comprised of eight members.

**SECTION 2:**

The Board of Directors shall be charged with the accomplishment of all club objectives except that all elections and final decisions concerning disciplinary action shall remain with the club membership.

**SECTION 3:**

The Board of Directors shall from time to time, make regulations in accordance with power herein given or on matters not herein provided for. No regulation shall be made by the Board of Directors which are contrary to other provisions of the by-law's without the approval of three-fourths (3/4) of the Active membership present and voting at any open meeting of the club as a whole, provided a quorum is present.
